Paul is now developing various original series for the market, including VINTAGE CRIMES (A returning "Cosy Crime" series about a crime writer and wine expert who investigates murders in wine growing regions around the world) and COLD FRONT (A Spy Thriller series following a group of MI6 officers operating across Europe in the years after WW2).

Paul is also a visiting tutor at the University of Salford MA in Scriptwriting for TV and Radio and an Associate Lecturer at Manchester Metropolitan University.
